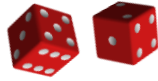

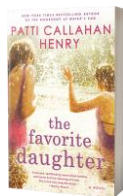
Neighbors Book Club Luncheon – October 24th

I have four teams signed up for **Grandslammer LXV**, so those of you who have finished or are interested in starting a marathon in the fall need to sign up now! What about some of you new members? Find a partner and sign up. The next marathon will be Chicago. As soon as we have eight teams ready to play, we will begin the next marathon.

The marathons are grouped by the player's preference – Chicago or Rubber bridge scoring. As soon as eight teams, in either group, are signed up, play will begin.
